Matthew 1:24-25 Luke 2:1-3

[Not much is often said about Joseph, but he was obviously a man who feared and trusted the Lord: he married an unwed-mother simply because a vision told him to. in a day when he could have had her stoned for 'cheating' on him]

Day 16

the CHILD comes!

Luke 2:4-7

[There is so much prophecy is represented in these few verses! and the most wonderous being: God was born~for you~for me.]

DAY 14

a virgin birth:

Matthew 1:22-23

[God told them this would happen. and still most people did not believe. And when Jesus began His ministry: ...Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see. {John 1:46} Do WE believe the prophecies that have yet to be fulfilled could, indeed, be wrought today?]

the shepherds are afaid:

Luke 2:8,9

[I am fairly certain I would be equally: sore afraid! What would you do?]

Luke 2:10-14

[the Greatest Message ever spoken!]

let US go, too!

Luke 2:15,16

[Let us go and find Jesus! for we have an even greater witness than Angels! the Written, Living Word...]

DAY 20

telling & pondering

Luke 2:17-19

[I must purpose THIS DAY to TELL of the great tidings! Do you think Mary pondered these things later also? when Jesus was being scorned. remembering how He was so honored at His birth contrasted with how rejected He was in His death. As a mother, I cannot even begin to contemplate how she must have felt during Jesus' entire life. as a child. His ministry. death. Have you ever wondered?]

DAY 21

wise men's tidings are troubling

Matthew 2:1-3

[Herod was troubled because he was a wicked ruler. How do you think the leaders of different countries would react if Jesus were born today? the people were troubled also. How would we react?]

DAY 22

in Bethlehem: AS IT IS WRITTEN

Matthew 2:4-8

[The priests and scribes of Israel KNEW about the prophesies for the Birth of the Messiah. yet men from afar were more interested in there fulfillment and the coming of The King.]

DAY 23

rejoicing with treasures!

Matthew 2:9-12

[Hearing from the religious leaders about where they should go, following a star from a far away land, they REJOICED. and obeyed God.]

DAY 24

fleeing to Egypt, to be called OUT

Matthew 2:13-15

[The Lord could have had them flee to any number of different regions or countries, but He chose Egypt- a picture of the world. Jesus was sent into the world, and the called OUT of the world- an example for so He calls us too.]
